- Wood Products in Central Point -

The Timber Products facility in Central Point was researched, designed and built by Phil Hunter, the Rogue Valley Model Railroad Club's Modeler of the Year for 2015.

The structure is fairly large but there is quite a bit of fine detail which make the model come alive. All we need now is a scaled down Lionel milk can unloader, modified ro move the pallets around. This is a big improvement over the place holder structure

It was designed and constructed by new members, Paul and Dave Hendrickson. The design was based on pictures of a similar facility near Medford. These pictures don't do the model justice.
